FINAL DETERMINATION

Upon all the findings of fact heretofore filed herein, being those numbered from 1 to 22, inclusive, and those this day filed herein, being numbered from 23 to 50, inclusive, all of which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the defendant is liable to petitioners in the sum of \$2,067,166.00, less the sum of \$41,150.14, being the total amount shown in the summary appearing in Finding 50, which is hereby allowed as offsets, leaving a balance of \$1,626,015.86

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that petitioners do have and recover of and from defendant the sum of \$1,626,015.86.
