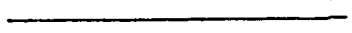

ORDER FIXING TIME FOR ORAL ARGUMENT

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That Monday, July 29, 1957, at ten o'clock in the forenoon at the hearing room of the Commission in the city of Washington, D. C., is set for oral argument on the claim of the petitioner in Dockets Nos. 31 and 37, such oral argument to be on the issues (1) of the claimant's capacity to assert its claim, and (2) to the right of the claimant to recover. Claimants in the dockets, other than 31 and 37, will not be required to argue their cases on the issues mentioned above at the time and place fixed above unless they desire to do so, except as required in the next succeeding paragraph.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That each of the claimants in the respective dockets set forth in the caption, other than the petitioner, Indians of California, in said Dockets 31 and 37, may on or before July 15, 1957, file herein and serve upon the other claimants and the defendant, named in the caption, briefs on the question whether said Indians of California have the exclusive right to assert and have determined the claim for that portion of the lands in the State of California claimed by the respective tribal claimants, other than the Indians of California; the claimants named in the caption, other than the claimant filing a brief, and the defendant, shall file and serve reply briefs on or before July 25, 1957. The question so presented is also set for argument at the above time and place.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED, That the original of this order shall be filed in Docket No. 31, and copies thereof, certified by the Clerk, shall be filed in each of the other dockets set forth above.
