INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

In keeping with the opinion, and upon the findings of fact this day filed in the above entitled action, which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law, that the Chickasaw Nation is entitled to recover the sum of \$190,934.78 from the United States of America, less credits and offsets, if any, to which defendant may be entitled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the defendant shall amend its answer in this action by setting forth the amount of offsets, credits, counter claims, or other demands against the claimant, authorized by the Indian Claims Commission Act, in the manner and within the time required by Section 12 of the Rules of Procedure of this Commission.
