ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES AND
REIMBURSABLE AND OTHER EXPENSES

Upon consideration of the petitions filed herein by the plaintiffs and by witness E. O. Fuller on August 6, 1958, the objections and comments of the defendant and the Bureau of Indian Affairs on November 12, 1958, and other documents in the record including objections of the plaintiff tribe, and after an oral hearing on said matters on December 8, 1958 to which all interested parties so desiring were represented by counsel; and in accordance with the opinion filed herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that from the award of \$416,240.85 made to the plaintiffs June 17, 1958, there shall be paid to the following named persons the following sums:

1. To Attorneys E. L. Crawford and Joseph W. Creagh as attorneys' fees the sum of \$41,624.08, in accordance with agreements and assignments filed, which net sum shall be in full settlement for legal services rendered in the prosecution of the above entitled cause, said sum to be divided between said attorneys in accordance with their agreements.

2. For reimbursable costs and expenses of the litigation paid or incurred for plaintiffs, the following:

To E. L. Crawford as reimbursement of expenses incurred in the litigation by him \$1645.30, \$1270.30 of which amount is a reimbursement of expenses advanced by him, and \$375.00 of which is to pay for services rendered by Dorothy Crawford.

3. To E. O. Fuller for services rendered as witness-for plaintiffs, the sum of \$5,000.00.

4. The expenditure of \$876.99 made by E. L. Crawford from Indian fund on deposit with him is approved.
