THIRD INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Upon the additional Findings of Fact this day filed herein, the Interlocutory Order relating to Claims VI and VII filed herein on July 14, 1950, and the Findings of Fact and Interlocutory Order made and entered herein on the 17th day of June, 1957, all of which are hereby made a part hereof, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the claimant tribe of Indians is entitled to recover from the defendant the following sums:

On Claims I and II, the sum of \$4,427,700.00;  
 On Claim III, the sum of \$97,380.00;  
 On Claim IV, the sum of \$3,394,390.10;  
 On Claim V, the sum of \$6,000.00;  
 On Claim VI, the sum of \$155.00;  
 On Claim VII, the sum of \$31.90, together with interest on the \$31.90 at 5 percent per annum from March 3, 1893; less such offsets as may hereafter be determined;

IT IS ORDERED, THEREFORE, That the defendant shall, within the time fixed by the rules of the Commission, amend its answer by setting forth therein the offsets, counterclaims, or other demands it may have against the claimant tribe of Indians.
