CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND FINAL AWARD

Upon the supplemental findings of fact this day filed in these consolidated dockets, the findings of fact heretofore filed on the 26th day of March, 1954, and the findings of fact and interlocutory order made and entered herein on the 17th day of September, 1956, the findings of fact filed herein on the 30th day of September, 1957, save and except as said previous findings have been amended, all of which are hereby made a part hereof, this Commission concludes as a matter of law:

That the Miami Tribe, also known as the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma, petitioners in Docket No. 67, and the Miami Indian Tribe and the Miami Tribe of Indians, et al., plaintiffs in Docket No.124, jointly as representatives of the Miami Tribe as the same existed on October 6, 1818, are entitled to recover \$4,935,225.00 as the value of 4,291,500 acres less credits and offsets of \$287,757.33, that is an award of \$4,647,467.67.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all findings and decrees heretofore made, except as amended by the findings of fact made as of this date and by this order and final award, shall be and are hereby confirmed and made final.
