ORDER ALLOWING REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES INCURRED

Upon consideration of the petition of the attorney for petitioners for allowance of reimbursable expenses incurred in the prosecution of the above-entitled case and after a hearing on said petition and in accordance with the opinion filed herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that from the award of \$567,000.00 made to the petitioners in this case on December 4, 1959, there shall be paid, in addition to those fees and reimbursable expenses allowed by order dated May 31, 1960, the following reimbursable costs and expenses of the litigation:

To Bernard J. Long, attorney, the sum of \$3,157.30, which sum includes the claimed expenses of A. A. Bardwell, of Burns, Oregon, appraiser, in the amount of \$363.60, of D. C. Eggleston, of Burns, Oregon, appraiser, in the amount of \$325.00, and of M. A. Palmer, of Burns, Oregon, appraiser, in the amount of \$562.72.

To the United States National Bank of Portland, Oregon, as Executor of the Estate of Charles B. McConnell, deceased, the sum of \$6,247.20.
