FINAL JUDGMENT

Upon Joint Motion of the parties for Entry of Final Judgment in the above numbered docket pursuant to the Stipulation of Settlement filed herein on the 22nd of June, 1961, which stipulation is hereby incorporated by reference into and made a part of this judgment; and evidence both oral and written in support of said motion having been received and considered at a hearing on said matter on the 23rd day of June, 1961; and it appearing that said settlement was found to be fair and just to the parties; and it appearing that there is no just reason for delay in entering final judgment, in accordance with said stipulation, in favor of the Snake or Paiute Indians of the Oregon Area on the claim herein with respect to the tract of land described by metes and bounds in Finding No. 23, of the Findings of Fact entered by the Commission herein on March 24, 1959;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. That the Stipulation of Settlement entered into by the parties, a copy of which was received in evidence in this case and marked Petitioners' Exhibit A, is hereby approved and adopted by the Commission and hereby by reference made a part hereof;

2. That the claim herein with respect to the tract of land described by metes and bounds in Finding No. 23 of the Findings of Fact entered herein

by the Commission on March 24, 1959, be, and hereby is separated from all other claims herein; and

3. That the Joint Motion of the parties in respect to said claim be, and hereby is granted; that the petitioners, for and in behalf of, and for the benefit of the members, and descendants of members, of the Snake or Paiute Indians of the Oregon Area as described, shall recover from the defendant, the sum of \$3,650,000;

And accordingly that judgment be, and is hereby entered on said claim in favor of petitioners for and in behalf of, and for the benefit of the members, and descendants of members, of the Snake or Paiute Indians of the Oregon Area as described, against the said defendant for the said sum of \$3,650,000.
