FINAL AWARD

Upon all the findings of fact heretofore filed herein, being those numbered 1 through 56 and those this day filed herein, being numbered 57 through 68, all of which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioners herein are entitled to recover from the defendant for and on behalf of and for the benefit of the members and descendants of members of the Red Lake and Pembina Bands, as such bands were constituted and recognized by the United States at the time of the Treaty of October 2, 1863, the sum of \$3,369,726.00, less the sums of \$512,518.43, representing payments on the claim, and \$699,061.57, representing allowable gratuitous offsets, leaving a net balance of \$2,158,146.00.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSION that the petitioners herein for and on behalf of and for the benefit of the members and descendants of members of the Red Lake and Pembina Bands, as such bands were constituted and recognized by the United States at the time of the Treaty of October 2, 1863, do have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$2,158,146.00.
