ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES

Upon consideration of the petition for allowance of attorneys' fees filed on June 28, 1961, the response thereto filed by the defendant on August 4, 1961, the amended petition filed on September 14, 1961, and the brief in opposition thereto filed in behalf of heirs of Kenneth R. L. Simmons, deceased, on September 28, 1961, and after a hearing on said petition, as amended, at which all interested parties were represented by counsel, and in accordance with the opinion filed herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that from the award of \$10,242,987.70 made to the Crow Tribe of Indians on May 29, 1961, there shall be paid the sum of \$921,868.62 to Ralph G. Wiggenhorn, the law firm of Wiggenhorn, Hutton, Schiltz & Sheehy, Ernest L. Wilkinson, the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker, and the Executor or Administrator of the Estate of Kenneth R. L. Simmons, deceased, or in the event the administration of said estate has been completed then the heirs and distributees of the Estate of Kenneth R. L. Simmons, deceased, which sum shall be in full settlement for legal services rendered in the prosecution of the said claim of the Crow Tribe.
