FINAL DETERMINATION OR JUDGMENT

Upon the joint motion of the parties for entry of final determination, or judgment, in the above numbered Docket 242, pursuant to a stipulation of compromise settlement, filed herein on the 28th day of June, 1962, which stipulation is incorporated by reference in this determination or judgment; and it appearing that appeals by the petitioners and the defendant from the Interlocutory Order made and entered herein on the 1st day of December, 1958, and amended on the 2nd day of July, 1959, have been dismissed by the United States Court of Claims; and the Commission having on the 29th day of June, 1962, held a hearing on said motion; and evidence both oral and written having been received and considered; and Findings of Fact and an Opinion having been made and entered in said matter; and it further appearing that said compromise settlement was help to be fair and just to said parties; and that final determination or judgment should be entered in accordance with said Stipulation, Findings of Fact and Opinion;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the joint motion of the parties for final determination or judgment be, and the same is hereby granted; that the petitioners herein, for and on behalf of, and for the benefit of the members and descendants of members of the above named petitioners as such petitioners were constituted and recognized by the United States at the time of the said Treaty of Olympia, which became effective March 8, 1859, do have and recover of and from the defendant the net sum of \$205,172.40.
