INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Upon the findings of fact this day filed herein and which are made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioners herein are entitled to recover from the defendant for and on behalf of, and for the benefit of, the members and descendants of members of the Emigrant New York Indians, as such Emigrant New York Indians were constituted on June 25, 1832, the sum of \$1,603,600.00, less the sum of \$114,970.40, representing consideration received therefor, and making a net sum of \$1,488,629.60.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the petitioners herein, for and on behalf of, and for the benefit of, the members and descendants of members of the Emigrant New York Indians, as such group was constituted on June 25, 1832, have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$1,488,629.60, less such offsets, if any, that may be allowable under the Indians Claims Commission Act.
