IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that from the award made the petitioner there shall be paid the sum of \$18,112.86 to the following named persons and estates:

1. To Georgia W. Honnold, as Executrix of the Estate of Arthur B. Honnold, deceased, the sum of \$2,166.26, which sum is in full payment for reimbursable expenses incurred by the said Arthur B. Honnold, now deceased, in the prosecution of the claims of the petitioner.

2. To the law firm of Wheeler and Wheeler, John Wheeler, Jr., Robert Wheeler, and John Wheeler, Jr., as Executor of the Estate of John M. Wheeler, deceased, the sum of \$15,946.60, which sum is in full payment for reimbursable expenses incurred by them in the prosecution of the claims of the petitioner.
