FINAL ORDER

Upon the findings of fact and supplemental findings of fact heretofore filed in Docket 67 (consolidated) on March 26, 1954, on September 7, 1956, and on June 30, 1960, and in Docket 65 (consolidated) on March 26, 1956, and upon the Findings of Fact 1 through 16 previously entered herein, and Findings of Fact 17 through 24, this day filed herein, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioners are entitled to recover from the defendant on behalf of the Wea Tribe or Nation of Indians as constituted at the time of the Treaty of October 2, 1818 (7 Stat. 186), the sum of \$937,250.00 less the sum of \$34,478.16 as payment on the claim, being the consideration paid by the United States to the Wea Tribe or Nation of Indians for the 1818 Wea cession of the subject tract, the sum of \$2,294.54 being gratuitous expenditures, and the sum of \$24,000 being the 1832 fair market value of 125 sections of the 250 section grant made jointly to the Wea and Piankashaw Tribes by the United States which amount we have found to be a proper offset, leaving therefore a net award of \$876,477.30,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the petitioners herein on behalf of the Wea Nation or Tribe of Indians as constituted at the time of the October 2, 1818 treaty (7 Stat. 186), recover from the United States the sum of \$876,477.30.
