FINAL JUDGMENT

Upon the Findings of Fact 1 through 12 inclusive, previously entered herein, and Findings of Fact 13 through 30 inclusive, this day filed herein, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioners are entitled to recover from the defendant on behalf of the Delaware Nation of Indians as constituted at the time of the Treaty of October 3, 1818 (7 Stat. 188), the sum of \$2,218,925.00 less the sum of \$124,674.73 as payment on the claim, being the consideration paid by the United States to the Delaware Nation for the 1818 Delaware cession of the subject land; and less the sum of \$465,664.00 being the fair market value of 1,884,160 acres granted to the Delaware Nation; and less the sum of \$1,341.63 being gratuitous expenditures which amount we have found to be a proper offset, leaving, therefore, a net award of \$1,627,244.64,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the petitioners herein on behalf of the Delaware Nation of Indians as constituted at the time of the Treaty of October 3, 1818 (7 Stat. 188), recover from the United States of America the sum of \$1,627,244.64.
