FINAL JUDGMENT AND  
ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS FEES

Upon the joint motion of the parties in the above entitled docket number for an entry of final judgment pursuant to their stipulation filed herein on December 31, 1963, and a hearing upon said motion having been held on the 31st of December, 1963, and evidence both oral and written having been offered in support of said motion, and the Commission having made and entered its Findings of Fact and Opinion in said matter, in which it was found that said motion should be granted, and the Commission being fully advised in the premises,

And it further appearing that the attorney of record for said Indian petitioners on January 17, 1964, filed a petition for the allowance of Attorney fee for services rendered by the contract attorneys for said Indian petitioners, and the Commission having considered said petition and having entered Findings of Fact thereon as a part of said compromise proceedings which Findings are numbered 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36, and which show that the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker are entitled to an attorney fee for their services in said above named docket in the sum of \$215,000;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that in accordance with said Findings Opinion, and Stipulation, which by this reference are made a part of this order, the joint motion of the parties for final judgment be, and it is hereby granted in favor of said petitioners and against the defendant for the sum of \$2,500,000 and the said petitioners do have and recover from the said defendant the said sum.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in accordance with said Findings of Fact, numbered 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36, which by this reference are made a part of this order, the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun, & Barker is allowed an attorney fee of \$215,000 for their services to the said petitioner Indians, and that said sum is ordered paid from the

judgment funds to be hereafter deposited in the United States Treasury to the credit of the petitioners, to the said law firm.
