ORDER AMENDING FINDINGS OF FACT

Upon its own motion and in compliance with the decision of the Court of Claims in the subject case, being Appeal No. 11-61, decided April 5, 1963, and for the reasons set forth in the opinion this date filed herein, the Commission orders:

(1) That Finding of Fact No. 1, entered on June 28, 1960, be amended by striking out the last sentence thereof and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

The Minnesota Chippewa Tribe is not the successor in interest to the claim presented under Docket No. 18-B but is entitled to maintain this action in a representative capacity on behalf of the Mississippi bands and the Pillager and Lake Winnibigoshish bands of Chippewas who were parties to the Treaty of February 22, 1855 (10 Stat. 1165).

(2) That Finding of Fact No. 2, entered on June 28, 1960, be stricken and there be set forth in lieu thereof the following:

2. The individual Indians named as petitioners are descendants of the original members of the Mississippi, Pillager, and Lake Winnibigoshish bands, and as such are also entitled to maintain this action in a representative capacity on behalf of the Mississippi bands and the Pillager and Lake Winnibigoshish bands of Chippewas who were parties to the Treaty of February 22, 1855.

(3) That Finding of Fact No. 47, entered on June 28, 1960, be stricken and that no finding be entered therefor.

(4) That Finding of Fact No. 50, entered on June 28, 1960, be stricken and there be set forth in lieu thereof the following:

50. The Commission finds that the remaining portions of Royce Area 357 were held by the Mississippi bands under recognized title granted to said Mississippi bands by the defendant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other Findings of Fact entered by this Commission on June 28, 1960, are re-entered and affirmed.
