
ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY FEE AND REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

Upon consideration of the application of the attorney for allowance of fees and expenses, and upon consideration of the findings of fact in the matter of said application which are this day filed herein and made a part hereof,


IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that out of the funds awarded to the petitioner in this case by the amended final judgment entered herein on December 11, 1963, if and when they are deposited in the United States Treasury to the credit of petitioner, the sum of \$6,200.00 shall be paid to Frederick W. Post, attorney for petitioner, which sum shall be in full compensation for legal services rendered the Duwamish Tribe of Indians in the prosecution of its claim against the United States.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that there shall also be paid out of the said judgment funds, if and when they are deposited in the United States Treasury to the credit of the petitioner, the sum of \$1,565.77 to Frederick W. Post in payment of reimbursable expenses incurred by him in the prosecution of petitioner's claim.


