AMENDED FINAL AWARD

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Amended Final Award entered herein on June 18, 1962 be amended to read as follows:

Upon the Findings of Fact heretofore filed herein, being those numbered 1 through 69, as amended, all of which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioners herein are entitled to recover from the defendant for and on behalf of and for the benefit of the Red Lake and Pembina Bands, as such bands were constituted and recognized by the United States at the time of the Treaty of October 2, 1863, the sum of \$3,369,726.00, less the sums of \$635,774.87, representing payments on the claim, and \$699,061.57, representing allowable gratuitous offsets, leaving a net balance of \$2,034,889.56, which net balance shall be divided as follows:

- (1) On behalf of and for the benefit
of the Red Lake Band \$1,797,761.74
- (2) On behalf of and for the benefit
of the Pembina Band \$ 237,127.82

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commission that the petitioners herein for and on behalf of and for the benefit of the Red Lake and Pembina Bands, as such bands were constituted and recognized by the United States at the time of the Treaty of October 2, 1863, do have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$2,034,889.56, said sum to be divided as follows:

- (1) On behalf of and for the benefit
of the Red Lake Band \$1,797,761.74
- (2) On behalf of and for the benefit
of the Pembina Band \$ 237,127.82
