INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Upon the findings of fact numbered 1 to 24, inclusive, this day filed herein and which are made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioner, Sac and Fox Tribe of Missouri, is entitled to recover from defendant for and on behalf of the Sac and Fox Tribe of Missouri as such Tribe was constituted on July 11, 1854, the sum of \$240,000, less the sum of \$48,000 representing consideration received therefor, and making a net sum of \$192,000.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the petitioner herein, Sac and Fox Tribe of Missouri, for and on behalf of the Sac and Fox Tribe of Missouri as such tribe was constituted on July 11, 1854, have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$192,000, less such credits and offsets, if any, as may be allowable under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
