AMENDED INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the interlocutory order entered in this cause on October 8, 1962, be, and the same is hereby amended by striking said order and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

UPON THE FINDINGS OF FACT this day filed herein and which are made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioners herein are entitled to recover from the defendant for and on behalf of, and for the benefit of, the Emigrant New York Indians as said group was constituted on June 25, 1832, the sum of \$1,603,600.00, less the sum of \$150,776.00 representing payments on the claim, and making a net sum of \$1,452,824.00.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the petitioners herein, the Emigrant New York Indians for and on behalf of and for the benefit of said Emigrant New York Indians as such group was constituted on June 25, 1832, have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$1,452,824.00, less such offsets, if any, as may be allowable under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
