ORDER CORRECTING ERROR IN COMPUTATIONS

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard on defendant's motion to correct error in computations which was filed on August 13, 1963, and on petitioners' response requesting that said matter be the subject of oral argument at the hearings on offsets, which request was granted by order of this Commission entered September 4, 1963, and

IT APPEARING after argument of counsel for the parties that defendant is entitled to be credited with 23.87% of the entire 500,000 acres reserved to the New York Indians rather than 23.87% of one-half of 375,000 acres plus 23.87% of 125,000 acres as found in the valuation phase of this case at 11 Ind. Cl. Comm. 336, 357, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that 23.87% of 500,000 acres amounts to 119,350 acres, which at the valuation of 80¢ per acre found by the Commission equals \$95,480.00 and that this amount added with the 69,120 acres found to have been reserved to the Stockbridge-Munsee, and Brothertown Indians outside of the 500,000 acre reserve and which at 80¢ per acre had a value of \$55,296.00 makes a total consideration of \$150,776.00 which the Commission finds should have been deducted from the interlocutory award of \$1,603,600.00, thereby leaving a net interlocutory award of \$1,452,824.00;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Finding of Fact No. 66 heretofore entered in this case on the 8th day of October, 1962, and the Opinion accompanying the same be, and they are hereby, amended to conform with this order and to show an interlocutory award to petitioners in the sum of \$1,452,824.00 instead of \$1,488,629.60.
