FINAL AWARD

Upon the findings of fact numbered 67 through 83 this day entered in this case, and which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that petitioners, the Emigrant New York Indians, are entitled to recover from the defendant for and on behalf of and for the benefit of the Emigrant New York Indians as such group was constituted on June 25, 1832, the sum of \$1,452,824.00, less the sum of \$139,351.35 representing allowable gratuitous offsets, and leaving a net balance of \$1,313,472.65.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED by the Commission that the petitioners herein, for and on behalf of and for the benefit of the Emigrant New York Indians, as such group was constituted on June 25, 1832, have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$1,313,472.65.
