ORDER ALLOWING REIMBURSEMENT
OF ATTORNEY EXPENSES

Upon consideration of the application of Bert Barefoot, Jr., attorney of record for the plaintiff, Otoe and Missouri Tribe, for an order allowing reimbursement to Bert Barefoot, Jr., the law firm of Weissbrodt, Weissbrodt & Liftin, and Marvin Sonosky, of expenses incurred and paid in connection with the prosecution of the claims of the said plaintiff in Docket No. 11-A, the defendant having had a copy of said application served upon it and no objection thereto was entered; and it appearing that a final judgment was entered herein on April 14, 1964 in favor of the plaintiff in the amount of \$1,750,000; and it appearing that the contracts for the employment of the attorneys provide for the reimbursement out of the recovery of necessary and reasonable expenses incurred by the attorneys in the prosecution of the claims; and hearing having been held before the Commission, and the Commission having considered the record in the case,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that out of the final award to the said Otoe and Missouri Tribe as made by the Commission on April 14, 1964, there shall be paid the sum of \$5,986.61 to Bert Barefoot, Jr., the sum of \$103.98 to the law firm of Weissbrodt, Weissbrodt & Liftin, and the

Sum of \$286.27 to Marvin Sonosky, in payment of reimburseable expenses incurred by them in the prosecution of the plaintiff's claim.
