FINAL AWARD

Upon the findings of fact numbered 1 through 22 this day entered in this case, and which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the plaintiff, The Seminole Nation, is entitled to recover from the defendant the sum of \$96,000.00, less the sum of \$32,320.00, representing the consideration received for the subject lease, and leaving a net balance of \$63,680.00.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED by the Commission that the plaintiff herein, for and on behalf and for the benefit of The Seminole Nation, as such group was constituted on July 15, 1926, have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$63,680.00.
