SECOND INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

Upon the findings of fact this day filed herein and which are made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that petitioners in Docket No. 40-K, Robert Dominic, et al., are entitled to recover from defendant on behalf of, and for the benefit of, the Grand River Band of Ottawa Indians, as such band was constituted on March 25, 1822, the sum of \$969,629.00, less the sum of \$32,337.33, representing consideration received, and making a net sum of \$937,291.67.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED that Robert Dominic, et al., have and recover of and from defendant the sum of \$937,291.67, for and on behalf of, and for the benefit of, the Grand River Band of Ottawa Indians as such Band was constituted on March 25, 1822, less such offsets, if any, as may be allowable under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
