NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the joint motion of the parties for final judgment be, and hereby is granted, and that accordingly judgment be, and is hereby entered in favor of petitioner, the Chemehuevi Tribe of Indians, against defendant for the total amount of \$996,834.81.
