AMENDED FINAL AWARD

In compliance with the decision of the Court of Claims in the matter of the subject case, Appeal No. 2-63, decided June 12, 1964, certiorari denied by the Supreme Court of the United States on December 7, 1964,

IT IS ORDERED that the Final Award, entered on November 26, 1962, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Upon the Findings of Fact Nos. 1 through 45 and the Interlocutory Order entered herein on June 29, 1960, and the Additional Findings of Fact Nos. 46 through 57 entered herein on November 26, 1962, and in compliance with the decision of the Court of Claims on June 12, 1964, all of which are hereby made a part hereof, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the petitioners are entitled to recover from the defendant the following sums, to-wit:

- (1) For Trust Land Funds unaccounted for by Agent Hutchinson, the sum of\$ 30,603.94 together with the interest thereon at 5% per annum from March 22, 1869 to March 22, 1934, in the sum of 99,462.80 together with interest at the rate of 4% per annum on \$30,603.94 from March 22, 1934.
- (2) For the appraised value of the Ottawa School Section of land, the sum of 22,600.00
- (3) For the appraised value of 1,280 acres of Ottawa lands conveyed to Ottawa University 7,490.00

- (4) For Treaty Funds received by Agent Hutchinson for delivery to the Ottawa Tribe and not accounted for, the sum of...\$ 3,354.75
- (5) For expenses of the 1872 and 1873 commission paid by the Ottawas, the sum of 1,202.42
- (6) For the value of School Lands in Trust in Liquidation, the sum of 43,691.25
- (7) For Agent Hutchinson's profit on sale of Townsite, the sum of115,372.68
- (8) For the profit by Kalloch and Hutchinson on sale of 4,348.79 acres of School Land Tract, the sum of 21,894.31
- (9) For Consideration from sale of 3,032.24 acres of school lands by Hutchinson, the sum of 24,396.17

or a total sum of \$370,068.32, plus the interest on the \$30,603.94, less the sum of \$2,028.77 representing allowable gratuitous offsets.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commission that the petitioners herein, for and on behalf of and for the benefit of the bands of Ottawa Indians which entered into the treaties of June 24, 1862 (12 Stat. 1237) and February 23, 1867 (15 Stat. 517), do have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$368,039.55, together with interest on \$30,603.94 at 4 per cent per annum from March 22, 1934.
