FINAL JUDGMENT

Upon the motion of the petitioner for entry of final judgment in the above-entitled docket, pursuant to a stipulation filed herein on the 25th day of January, 1965, which stipulation is hereby incorporated by reference into and made a part of this judgment; and upon evidence both oral and written in support of said motion received and considered at a hearing before the Commission on the 19th day of January, 1965, and Findings of Fact and an Opinion, having been made and entered in said matter, and it appearing that the compromise settlement of offsets agreed upon in said stipulation was found to be fair and just to the parties and that final judgment should be entered in accordance with said stipulation, Findings of Fact and Opinion;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the motion of the petitioner for final judgment be, and hereby is granted, and that accordingly judgment be, and is hereby entered in favor of petitioner, the Confederated Bands of Ute Indians, an identifiable group of American Indians against defendant for said sum of \$7,908,586.16.
