FINAL JUDGMENT

Upon the joint motion of the parties for entry of final judgment in the above-entitled docket, pursuant to a stipulation filed herein on January 26, 1965, which stipulation is hereby incorporated by reference into and made a part of this judgment; and upon evidence both oral and written in support of said motion received and considered at a hearing before the Commission on the 26th day of January, 1965, and findings of fact and an opinion having been made and entered this day in said matter, and it appearing that the compromise settlement of the petitioner's claim and the offsets claimed by the defendant agreed upon in said stipulation was found to be fair and just to the parties and that final judgment should be entered in accordance with said stipulation, findings of fact and opinion,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the joint motion of the parties for final judgment be, and hereby is granted, and that accordingly judgment be, and is hereby entered in favor of petitioner, the Shoshone Tribe of Indians of the Wind River Reservation against the defendant in the amount of \$120,000.00.
