ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY FEES

Upon consideration of the "Application For Allowance Of Attorneys Fees" filed herein on August 10, 1964, by the petitioner, Pritzker, Pritzker, and Clinton, and the Commission's Findings of Fact and Opinion this day entered herein, which Findings of Fact and Opinion are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes that in view of the valuable legal services that have been rendered to the Absentee Delaware Tribe of Indians in the successful presentation and prosecution of the claims in the above docket, attorney fees in the sum of \$162,724.46 are allowable in this case, and further, that for the present the petitioner law firm is entitled to 65% of the total attorney fees as set forth above, or the sum of \$105,770.90, and, that disposition of the balance of said total fee should be held in abeyance pending further order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, there shall be awarded as attorney fees from the final judgment previously entered in this docket the sum of \$162,724.46, and of that sum 65% or \$105,770.90 shall be awarded to the petitioner herein, the law firm of Pritzker, Pritzker, and Clinton.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, the disposition of the balance of said attorney fees shall be held in abeyance pending further order of the Commission.
