FINAL JUDGMENT

On January 25, 1965, the petitioners herein, and the defendant, filed a joint motion for the approval of a proposed compromise settlement of the Iowa Tribes of Kansas and Nebraska claims in the above-entitled docket based on a "Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment" attached to said motion.

On January 25, 1965, hearings were held on the aforesaid joint motions, and evidence was received in support thereof.

The Commission having this day entered its findings of fact and opinion, which findings of fact and opinion are hereby made a part of this order, concludes as a matter of law that the said proposed compromise settlement of Iowa claims in the above docket is both equitable and just to the petitioners and the defendant, and that there is no reason to postpone further the entry of a final judgment in accordance with the terms and provisions of the aforesaid stipulation for settlement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, the "Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment" entered into by the parties herein is hereby approved; the joint motion for the entry of final judgment pursuant to said stipulation is hereby granted; and the petitioners shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of \$1,372,267.50, subject to the terms and provisions set forth in the "Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to the joint motion and said stipulation of the parties herein that the petition in Docket No. 339 entitled Iowa Tribe v. United States be, and the same is, hereby dismissed with prejudice.
