ORDER AMENDING FINDING OF FACT

Additional facts having been brought to our attention with reference to the award areas in Docket Nos. 283, 295, and 319,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the description of the award area in Docket No. 22-E as set forth in Finding of Fact 34 of said docket be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of a line between Black Peak and a point on the south bank of Bill Williams River which is three miles upstream from where the said river enters the Colorado River, and a line between the N.W. corner of Section 19, T. 3 N., R. 26 E., SB Mer., California, and Mineral Hill, Arizona, which line marks a boundary of a portion of the award to the Mohave Tribe of Indians; thence east southeasterly along the award line to Mineral Hill; thence northwesterly on the award line between Mineral Hill and Crossman Point to the intersection with a line between the previously described point on the Bill Williams River and Mohave Springs; thence northerly to Mohave Springs; thence on a line easterly to Aubrey Peak; thence on a line in an easterly direction to the southeast corner of T. 13 N., R. 13 W.; thence on a line to the northeast corner of T. 11 N., R. 11 W.; thence on a line to Camp Wood; thence on a line in a northeasterly direction to a point on highway #89 three miles south of where said highway intersects highway #66; thence easterly on a line to Bellemont, Arizona; thence on a line southwesterly to the southwest corner of T. 12 N., R. 3 E., thence on a line in an

easterly direction to the juncture of Fossil Creek and the Verde River; thence on a line in a southeasterly direction to the crest of the Mazatzal Mountains; thence in a southeasterly direction following the crest of the Mazatzal and Pinal Mountains to Signal Peak; thence on a line to Sonora, Arizona; thence northwesterly on a line to the juncture of the Salt and Verde Rivers; thence northwesterly on a line to the most northern edge of Lake Pleasant; thence in a westerly direction on a line to Morrystown, Arizona; thence on a line in a southerly direction to the northernmost edge of the White Tank Mountains; thence on a line in a westerly direction to Burnt Mountain; thence on a line in a southerly direction to Yellow Medicine Butte; thence on a line in a southwesterly direction to Thumb Butte Tank; thence southwesterly on a line between Thumb Butte Tank and Long Mtn. to the intersection of a portion of the boundary of the award to the Quechan Tribe of Indians, said point of intersection being in T. 7 S., R. 19 W., G & SR meridian, Arizona, this point also being approximately 4 miles northeast of Long Mtn. on said line; thence northwesterly along the award line to the intersection of a line connecting Long Mtn. and Mohave Peak; thence northwesterly along the latter line to Mohave Peak; thence on a line in a northerly direction towards Moon Mtn. to the intersection of the Quechan Tribe of Indians award line in the southwest corner of T. 1 N., R. 21 W., G & SR meridian; thence northwesterly and northerly and westerly along award line to the intersection of line connecting Mohave Peak and Moon Mtn.; thence along the latter line to Moon Mtn.; thence in a northeasterly direction to Black Peak; thence on a line in a northeasterly direction to the point of beginning.
