ORDER AMENDING FINAL ORDER

On March 12, 1965, the Court of Claims, while affirming the Commission's decision in this docket (Appeal No. 12-63), modified the language in the Commission's Final Order by striking out the phrase therein "as constituted at the time of the October 2, 1818 treaty (7 Stat. 186)" so that said final order will accord with the Court's holding in the case of Minnesota Chippewa Tribe v. United States, C. Cls. Appeal No. 11-61, decided April 5, 1963, 315 F.2d 906. The Commission will therefore modify its Final Order of July 29, 1963, consistent with the ruling of the Court of Claims.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Commission's Final Order of July 29, 1963, in this docket be, and the same is hereby modified by striking out the phrase "as constituted at the time of the October 2, 1818 Treaty (7 Stat. 186)" and as modified said Final Order is re-entered as of this date.
