FINAL ORDER

Upon the Findings of Fact numbered 1 through 20 this day entered in the above-captioned case, and which are hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that petitioners, The Sac and Fox Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma, the Sac and Fox Tribe of Missouri, and the Sac and Fox Tribe of the Mississippi in Iowa, as successors in interest to the Sac and Fox Nation, are entitled to recover from the defendant for and on behalf of the Sac and Fox Nation the net sum of \$1,789,201.45, there being no offsets in favor of defendant in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED by the Commission that the petitioners herein, for and on behalf of the Sac and Fox Nation, have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$1,789,201.45.
