FINAL AWARD

Upon the motion of defendant filed in Docket No. 47 on June 3, 1965, for an order to docket separately as Docket No. 47-A the Tract C claim of petitioner from Docket No. 47, and for the entry of a final judgment thereon in Docket No. 47-A in accordance with the amended and supplemental findings of fact, opinion, and interlocutory order of the Commission entered in Docket No. 47 under date of November 29, 1957 (5 Ind. Cls. Comm. 636), affirmed by the Court of Claims on appeal on October 3, 1962 in Appeal No. 4-61 (158 C. Cls. 672); and during the hearing before the Commission held thereon on June 15, 1965, at which counsel for the parties were present, and during which counsel for petitioner consented to said motion, and counsel for the defendant waived defendant's right of appeal and claim to offsets herein, and it appearing to the Commission that there is no just reason for delay in entering final judgment on the Tract C claim of petitioner now docketed by order of the Commission entered June 18, 1965 as Docket 47-A, in accordance with the Commission's Interlocutory Order entered November 29, 1957 in said Docket No. 47.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that final judgment be and is hereby entered herein in favor of the Yakima Tribe of Indians, petitioner, and against the United States, defendant, for the fair market value of the 17,669.10 acres of land in Tract C on January 24, 1923, at \$1.25 an acre, or \$22,086.38, with interest thereon as a part of just compensation at the rate of 5% per annum from January 24, 1923 to January 24, 1934, and at the rate of 4% per annum from January 24, 1934 to the date of the entry of this final award, or a total final award herein to the Yakima Tribe of Indians in the amount of \$61,991.40.
