ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY FEES
AND ATTORNEY EXPENSES

Upon consideration of the petition for allowance of attorneys' fees, for services rendered in the above-entitled matters, and attorneys' expenses, and in accordance with the findings of the Commission filed herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that from the appropriation of \$996,834.81, made by Congress to satisfy the award of this Commission in like amount entered in this matter January 18, 1965, there shall be paid to the law firm of Strasser, Spiegelberg, Fried & Frank, represented herein by Arthur Lazarus, Jr., a partner and attorney of record; Marks & Marks, attorneys; Marvin J. Sonosky; and Louis L. Rochmes, the sum of \$99,683.48 as the attorneys' fee owing as the result of this litigation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that from said appropriation afore mentioned, the said attorneys shall have and recover the sum of \$2,481.96 for expenses paid by them for the benefit of said tribe of Indians.
