ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE AND REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

Upon consideration of the application of the attorneys for the plaintiffs for the allowance of a fee and reimbursable expenses, and upon consideration of the findings of fact in the matter of said application, which are this day filed herein and made a part hereof,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that out of the funds awarded to the plaintiffs in this case by the final judgment entered herein on October 7, 1963, the sum of \$75,438.00 shall be paid out of the judgment funds to E. L. Crawford and Joseph W. Creagh, attorneys for the plaintiffs, which shall be in full compensation for legal services rendered the plaintiff Indians in the prosecution of their claim against the United States.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that there shall also be paid out of the said judgment funds the sum of \$8,513.39 to E. L. Crawford in payment of allowable reimbursable expenses incurred by him in the prosecution of the claim.
