FINAL JUDGMENT

Upon all the findings of fact heretofore filed herein, being those numbered 1 through 40, and those this day filed herein, being those numbered 41 through 124, all of which are made a part of this judgment, the Commission finds that:

(1) The California portion of the Monos or Paiutes of Owens Valley tract had a fair market value on March 3, 1853, of \$710,000.00 and that the Nevada portion of said "Mono tract" had a fair market value on July 11, 1863, of \$225,000.00 and that, therefore, the total fair market value of the "Mono tract" as of the respective dates of valuation was \$935,000.00;

(2) The Nevada portion of the Paviotso or Paiutes of western Nevada tract had a fair market value on December 31, 1862, of \$15,750,000.00, and that the California portion of the said "Paviotso tract" had a fair market value on March 3, 1853, of \$250,000.00 and that, therefore, the total fair market value of the "Paviotso tract" as of the respective dates of valuation was \$16,000,000.00;

(3) The defendant is entitled to a credit in the amount of \$210,000.00 against the award hereby entered with respect to the said "Paviotso tract."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the petitioners shall have and recover from the defendant the following:

(1) For and on behalf of the Monos or Paiutes of Owens Valley the sum of \$935,000.00;

(2) For and on behalf of the Paviotso or Paiutes of Western Nevada the sum of \$16,000,000.00, less offsets in the sum of \$210,000.00, or a net sum of \$15,790,000.00.
