ORDER TO ENTER FINAL JUDGMENT AND TO POSTPONE
 ASSERTION OF OFFSETS TO OTHER CREEK NATION
 CLAIM CASES

Upon the joint motion of the parties in the above captioned claim filed with this Commission on August 11, 1966, for an Order to enter Final Judgment herein in accordance with the findings of fact and opinion and the award entered in this docket under date of December 15, 1965, and to postpone assertion of offsets to other Creek Nation claim cases, and it appearing to the Commission that there is no just reason for delay in entering a Final Judgment in this claim, in view of said joint motion of the parties,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Final Judgment be, and is hereby entered in favor of The Creek Nation, Plaintiff, and against the United States, defendant, for the sum of \$1,037,414.62, and determination of offsets is postponed to be asserted in other cases of the Creek Nation pending before this Commission and not yet fully adjudicated; provided, however, that such postponement shall not constitute a waiver by the defendant of any offset to which it is legally entitled under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
