O R D E R

Upon the findings of fact numbered 55 through 68 and the opinion this day entered herein, all of which are made a part of this order, the Commission concludes that:

(1) The petitioner has failed to establish any right to recover from the defendant under its "Tract B" claim, and, therefore, said claim must be disallowed; and

(2) That the boundary of the Yakima Reservation as surveyed by the defendant wrongfully excluded the "Tract D" area from the Reservation, and, therefore, the "Tract D" claim should be allowed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Tract B claim be and the same is hereby disallowed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Tract D claim be and the same is hereby allowed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the subject case shall proceed for the purpose of determining acreage, date of taking, and valuation.
