ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE

Upon consideration of the application by the attorneys for the plaintiff for the allowance of attorneys' fees for services rendered in prosecution of this claim, and upon consideration of the findings of fact in the matter of such application, which are this day filed herein and made a part of this order,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the sum of \$6,368.00, being ten percent of the award of \$63,680.00 made to the Seminole Nation on behalf of the Seminole Tribe of Indians of Oklahoma, be paid to Roy St. Lewis and Paul M. Niebell, as the attorneys' fees owing them as a result of litigation on behalf of the plaintiff Indians in this claim.
