ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO "CORRECT FINDINGS AND OPINION AND TO CERTIFY CORRECTED FINDINGS AND OPINION TO THE COURT OF CLAIMS"

On January 24, 1967, the defendant filed the above captioned motion to correct certain errors appearing in the Commission's Findings of Fact and Opinion of November 4, 1965 (16 Ind. Cl. Comm. 341). As stated by the defendant, the errors cited in its motion are harmless and "do not affect the issues involved before the Commission or on appeal,***." On January 30, 1967, the petitioner responded favorably to defendant's motion, but questioned the Commission's jurisdiction to act thereon. In view of the fact that the above docket is now pending on appeal before the Court of Claims (Appeal No. 2-66), and, while the Commission would be favorably disposed to granting defendant's motion on the premises, the Commission is of the opinion that it is without jurisdiction to grant said motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that, for the reasons stated herein, defendant's motion, as captioned above, be and the same is hereby denied.
