ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES

Upon consideration of the petition for allowance of attorneys' fee for services rendered in the above-entitled matter, and in accordance with the findings of the Commission filed herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that from the appropriation of \$4,431;622.18, made by Congress to satisfy the award of this Commission in like amount entered in this matter August 5, 1966, there shall be allowed as attorneys' fees the sum of \$443,162.22, from which shall be deducted and credited to the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead Reservation, Montana, the sum of \$27,833.33 for annual payments made under contracts with Messrs. Tunison and Kappler, or a net amount of \$415,328.89, to be paid to Robert W. Barker as the attorneys' fee owing as a result of this litigation.
