ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEY FEE AND REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

Upon consideration of the application of the attorney for petitioner for the allowance of a fee and reimbursable expenses upon which a hearing was held before the Commission on March 16, 1967, and upon consideration of the findings of fact in the matter of said application which are this day filed herein and made a part hereof,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that out of the funds awarded to the petitioner in this case by the final judgment entered herein on March 30, 1967, if and when they are deposited in the United States Treasury to the credit of the petitioner, the Snohomish Tribe of Indians, the sum of \$13,616.57 shall be paid to Frederick W. Post, attorney for petitioner, which sum shall be in full compensation for legal services rendered the Snohomish Tribe in the prosecution of its claim against the United States.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that there shall also be paid out of the said judgment funds, if and when they are deposited in the United States Treasury to the credit of the petitioner tribe, the sum of \$3,335.40 to Frederick W. Post in payment of allowable reimbursable expenses incurred by him in the prosecution of petitioner's claim.
