ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES

Upon consideration of the petition for attorneys' fees filed herein on February 10, 1967, and the defendant having had a copy of said petition mailed to it and no objection thereto being entered, and it appearing to the Commission that an attorney's contract was made between the petitioner and the law firm of Aaron, Aaron, Schimberg & Hess on November 5, 1949, the parties agreeing to compensation to the said Aaron, Aaron, Schimberg & Hess of ten percent (10%) of the net amount recovered on behalf of the petitioner, and that the said contract was extended at various times to March 8, 1970, which contract and extensions thereof were duly approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs as required by law; and it further appearing that the said law firm of Aaron, Aaron, Schimberg & Hess obtained a net recovery of \$1,313,472.65; and that, within the terms of compensation of the contract and its extensions set forth above, the said attorneys, Aaron, Aaron, Schimberg & Hess, have performed legal services for the petitioners in this Docket No. 75 for which they are entitled to receive ten percent (10%) of \$1,313,472.65.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that from the award made to the petitioner, there shall be paid the sum of \$131,347.26 to the law firm of Aaron, Aaron, Schimberg & Hess, which sum is in full settlement for services rendered by the said law firm in the prosecution of the claim of the petitioners.
