ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEES AND REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

Upon consideration of the application of the attorney for petitioner for the allowance of a fee and reimbursable expenses upon which a hearing was held before the Commission on March 17, 1967, and upon consideration of the findings of fact in the matter of said application which are this day filed herein and made a part hereof,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the said attorney, Frederick W. Post and Newton Day Simmons and Sara Simmons Hertz, heirs-at-law of the estate of Kenneth R. L. Simmons, deceased, and distributees of the estate of Hazel Day Simmons, deceased, be, and they are hereby allowed the sum of \$8,037.70, which sum shall be in full compensation for legal services rendered the Muckleshoot Tribe of Indians in the prosecution of its claim against the United States; that said sum shall be paid out of the appropriation which Congress of the United States has or may hereafter make to satisfy the final judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that there shall also be paid to Frederick W. Post out of the said judgment funds the sum of \$3,649.49 in payment of allowable reimbursable expenses incurred by him in the prosecution of petitioner's claim.
