ORDER SETTING ASIDE COMMISSION'S ORDER OF MAY 11, 1967
DISMISSING PETITIONS AND ALLOWING PETITIONERS TO FILE
PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND BRIEF

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the original of this order shall be filed in Docket No. 342-B, and that a copy thereof duly certified by the Clerk of the Commission shall be filed in Docket Nos. 342-C, 342-D and 368.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant shall have until October 1, 1967 within which to file its objections, proposed findings of fact and brief.
