FINAL JUDGMENTS IN DOCKET NOS. 142, 359 THROUGH 363,
EXCEPT THE GENERAL ACCOUNTING CLAIM IN DOCKET NO. 363

Upon the joint motion of the parties for the entry of final judgments in Docket Nos. 142, 359, 360, 361, 362 and 363, except the claim for an accounting denominated "Second Claim" in the first amended petition in Docket No. 363, and for an order joining the Sisseton and Wahpeton Sioux Indians of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana, as parties petitioner in Docket Nos. 142 and 359, all pursuant to a stipulation of settlement filed with the joint motion, which stipulation is hereby incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; the Commission having received and considered evidence on the matter, both oral and written, at a hearing held June 28, 1967; and the Commission having made and entered its Findings of Fact in said Docket numbers, and now being fully advised in the premises, the Commission concludes and determines that the settlement is fair and just to the parties; that the joint motion should be granted, the settlement approved and judgments entered herein accordingly.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commission that:

1. Docket No. 142. Final judgment be and is hereby entered in Docket No. 142 in favor of the Sisseton and Wahpeton Tribes of Sioux Indians against the defendant for the sum of \$5,097,575.00 and these tribes shall have and recover said sum from the defendant.

2. Docket No. 359. Final judgment be and is hereby entered in Docket No. 359 the sum of \$1,552,929.00 against the defendant, divided \$776,464.50 in favor of the Sisseton and Wahpeton Tribes of Sioux Indians and \$776,464.50 in favor of the Medawakanton and Wahpakoota Tribes of Sioux Indians and these tribes shall have and recover said sums from the defendant.

3. Docket No. 360. Final judgment be and is hereby entered in Docket No. 360 in favor of the Medawakanton Tribe of Sioux Indians against the defendant for the sum of \$1,129,359.00, and this tribe shall have and recover said sum from the defendant.

4. Docket No. 361. Final judgment be and is hereby entered in Docket No. 361 in favor of the Medawakanton Tribe of Sioux Indians against the defendant for the sum of \$64,680.00, and this tribe shall have and recover the said sum from the defendant.

5. Docket No. 362. Final judgment be and is hereby entered in Docket No. 362 in favor of the Medawakanton and Wahpakoota Tribes of Sioux Indians against the defendant for the sum of \$4,338,517.00 and these tribes shall have and recover said sum from the defendant.

6. Docket No. 363. Final judgment on the claim denominated "First Claim" in the first amended petition in Docket No. 363 be and is hereby entered in favor of the Medawakanton and Wahpakoota Tribes of Sioux Indians against the defendant for the sum of \$66,940.00, and these tribes shall have and recover said sum from the defendant; and all other claims in Docket No. 363, except the claim for an accounting and report denominated "Second Claim" in the first amended petition in Docket No. 363, be and the same are hereby dismissed with prejudice.

7. The Sisseton and Wahpeton Tribes of Sioux Indians named in Paragraphs Nos. 1 and 2 herein, the Medawakanton and Wahpakoota Tribe of Sioux Indians named in Paragraph Nos. 2, 5 and 6 herein, and the Medawakanton Tribe of Sioux Indians named in Paragraph Nos. 3 and 4 herein, are the landowning tribal entities which ceded to the United States the lands which are the subjects of the respective dockets.

8. The Sisseton and Wahpeton Sioux Indians of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana are hereby joined as parties petitioners in Docket Nos. 142 and 359 with the understanding that nothing herein shall be construed as agreement by the Sisseton and Wahpeton Sioux Tribe of North Dakota or the Sisseton and Wahpeton Sioux Tribe of South Dakota as to whether the Sisseton and Wahpeton Sioux Indians of the Fort Peck Reservation, Montana are, or are not, entitled to share in any award in Docket Nos. 142 and 359, but that question shall be left for final determination by the Secretary of the Interior and Congress.
