ORDER DISMISSING CLAIMS DESIGNATED
SECOND AND THIRD CAUSES OF ACTION

Upon defendant's motion, dated April 13, 1964, to dismiss the claims in the petition filed herein on August 8, 1951, which are designated as the "second cause of action" (Petition, p. 4) and the "third cause of action" (Petition, p. 5), and it appearing that the petitioning American Indians residing on the Maricopa-Ak Chin Indian Reservation did by resolution number M-71-58, dated February 20, 1958, authorize and direct their attorneys to move to dismiss the said second and third causes of action, and it further appearing that by letter dated June 12, 1962, addressed to the petitioners' attorney, the Acting Solicitor of the Department of the Interior did approve the said resolution and authorized dismissal of the said second and third causes of action, and the Commission now being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the claims designated as the second and third causes of action be and the same are hereby dismissed with prejudice.
